Aspire receives \$50,000 toward new record system

Aspire of Western New York on Friday received a \$50,000 state grant to purchase a \$250,000 electronic medical record system.

The agency, which provides services for 2,000 children and adults with developmental disabilities, will join the growing list of participants regionally in HealtheLink.

HealtheLink is the local consortium of medical providers and health insurers that is working to link by computer local patients, doctors and insurers.
